1/4 cup almonds            1/2 cup raisins

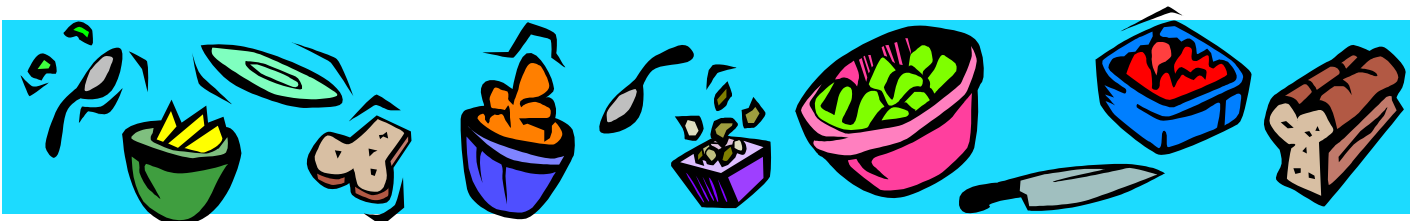
1 (1.69 ounce) package candy coated milk chocolate pieces such as M&Ms.
